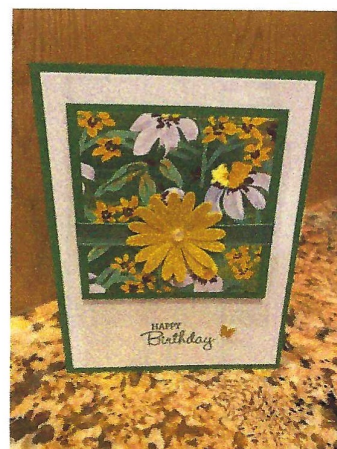
6 X 6 ONE SHEET WONDER



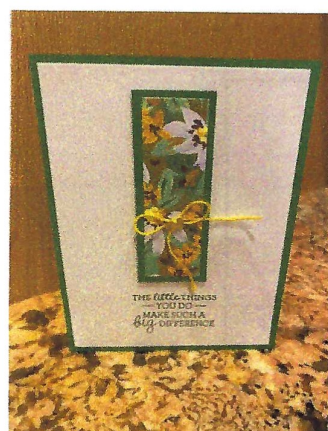
Card 1



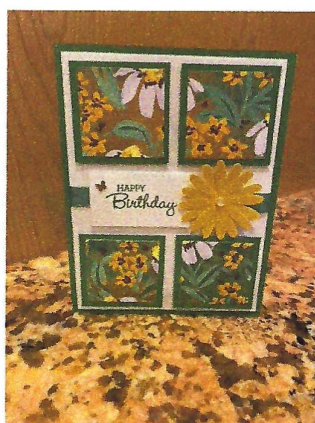

Card 6

1. Each card starts with a Garden Green 8 1/2 x 5 1/2 card base scored at 4 1/4.
2. For Card 1 and 5 add Garden Green ribbon (6 inches) as shown in picture to the Basic White 5 1/2 x 4 layers.
3. Stamp sentiment from Pansy Patch stamp set as shown in the pictures to each of the Basic White layer. Adhere the Basic White to the front of the card.
4. Match up each 6x6 DSP to the corresponding Garden Green pieces. Then add dimensionals to the back.
5. For card 2 and 3 adhere the Garden Green ribbon to DSP pieces. Add a bow to the front of the DSP piece for Card 2.
6. Adhere all DSP pieces to the front of the cards as shown and add embellishments as shown or however you would like. It's your card!
7. Stamp your inside sentiment adhere to card and you're done!

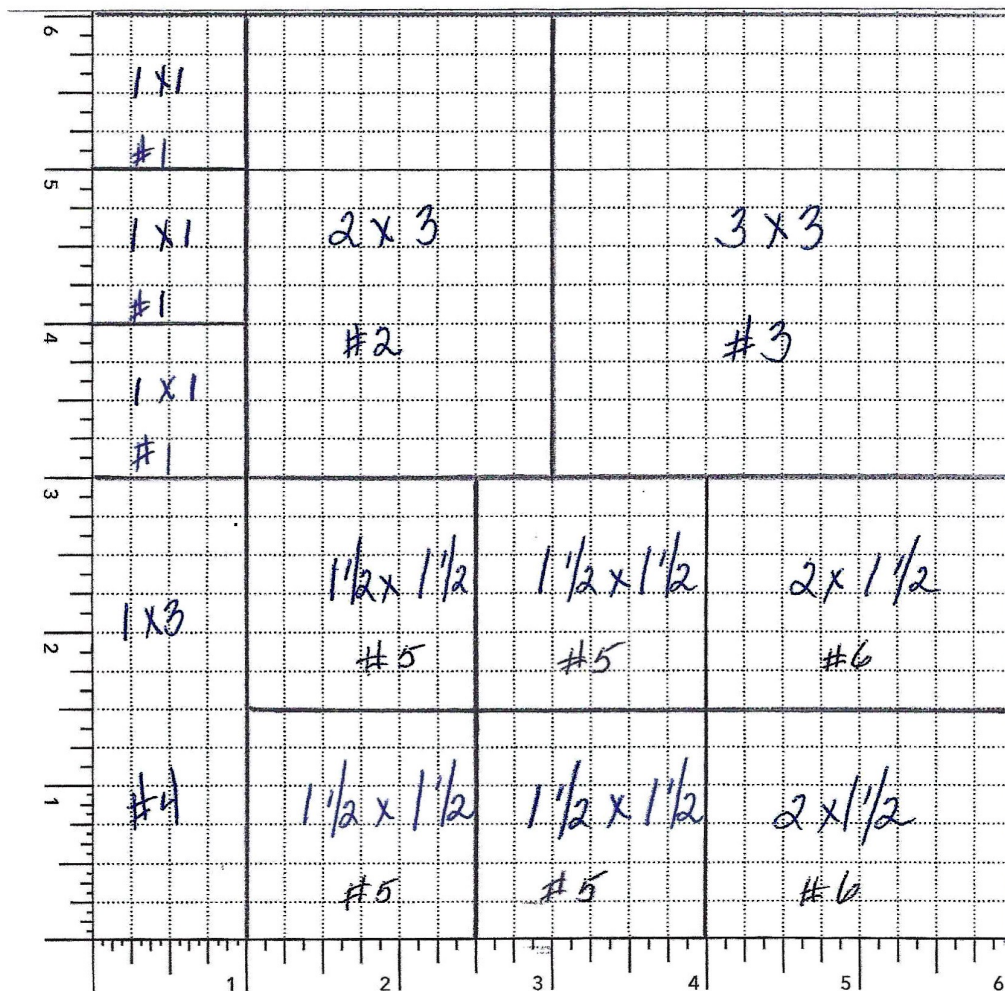

6 X 6 ONE SHEET WONDER



Fresh as A Daisy DSP # 161289 and cut to 6 x 6 and then cut as shown above.

Cardstock for DSP layers are 1/8" additional to the above measurements. Color - Garden Green #102584

Card #1 - 3 each 1 1/4 x 1 1/4

Card #2 - 1 each 2 1/4 x 3 1/4

Card #3 - 1 each 3 1/4 x 3 1/4

Card #4 - 1 each 1 1/4 x 3 1/4

Card #5 - 4 each 1 1/4 x 1 1/4

Card #6 - 2 each 2 1/4 x 1 1/4

Card Base - Garden Green #102584 - 6 each of 8 1/2 x 5 1/2

Front and inside layer - Basic White #159229 12 each of 5 1/4 x 4 and one scrap piece for card #5 sentiment

Scraps of Crushed Curry #131199 - punch 4 Medium Daisies for cards 3 and 5

Embellishments:

Brushed Brass Butterflies #158136

Opal Rounds #154289 (R)

Real Red and Garden Green Ribbon Combo # 159577

Tools:

Paper Trimmer #152392

Medium Daisy Punch #149517 (R)

Ink:

Garden Green #147089
